

DESIGN PACKAGES

Consultation or Landscape Master Plan \$125/hour

A one or two hour consultation is the perfect jumping off point for DIYers and those looking for broad design ideas, to develop priorities, to evaluate the overall health and success of their landscape, or to establish a maintenance plan for their property. Upon receiving your consultation inquiry via email, we reach out to set up a free 15-20 minute phone call to discuss your property and design goals, and to determine whether a one or two hour meeting is more appropriate. A one hour consultation is enough to develop basic design concepts for a smaller yard, one or two distinct areas, or to create a maintenance plan for your property, while two hours (or more) is better suited for visioning new design concepts for a entire property, to develop more complex design ideas, create a design + maintenance plan for a kitchen garden, or create a landscape master plan.

During the onsite meeting with one of our designers we will discuss design concepts and goals, assess plant health, scout for invasives, and analyze site conditions and challenges. After the consultation you will receive a written report addressing your areas of concern, which can include site analysis, maintenance recommendations, infrastructure improvements, invasive species mitigation strategies, garden placement and plant recommendations. Visual examples of design elements via a mood board can also be included upon request. Soil tests are available for \$35/sample which includes packaging + shipping.

This document can be used to guide future project implementation with Hedgewitch Horticulture and support DIY maintenance work. Billable hours include travel to site, onsite meeting + property assessment, and drafting of the written report and mood board.

A landscape master plan is a great option for clients who want to work with us long term to develop a strategy to be implemented over a timeline of 3-10 years. We work with clients to develop a customized approach that works with their budget, their landscape, and their property goals. This Master Plan can include suggestions for DIYers or can be written to include design briefs for each element of the project.

Billable hours for consultations and master plans include on site consultation, scheduled follow up phone calls, drafting of briefs or deliverables, and travel to site.

Garden Design \$750-1500

A garden design package includes: a 15-20 minute initial phone call; a 1 hour site meeting; 1 soil sample for soil test; 1 design brief including drawing, mood board, and installation proposal; 1 30 min follow up phone call; and one round of revisions.



Our process begins similarly to a consultation with an initial phone call followed by a site visit. In addition to completing site analysis and listening to your design goals and property concerns at our site meeting, we also take appropriate measurements for the size and scope of the project, track the sunlight, and take a soil sample.

We will analyze site conditions and challenges, and the collected information from our meeting off site as we create your new design. Following the consultation you will receive a written design brief which include:, a detailed planting plan, plant and materials list, scope of work and installation estimate. Upon receiving your design brief we will schedule a follow up phone call to review the project scope together, hear any feedback or answer any questions, and perform 1 round of design revisions if applicable. We are happy to complete any other desired rounds of edits or revisions, or produce a second drawing, however these are not included in the design scope and any subsequent design revisions or major changes to the scope will be billed at our design rate of \$125/hour.

The cost of installation of designs of this size vary based on scope, site challenges, and plant selection but tend to fall in a range from \$3,000-10,000. We are happy to accommodate your budget, and a knowledgeable home gardener could use the design materials to self-install their garden for savings on labor. We offer plant and material sourcing and delivery if such support is desired for DIYers.

Property Design \$1500-3,500+

A property design package includes: a 15-20 minute initial phone call; a 1+ hour site meeting; multiple soil samples for soil test; 1 design brief including drawing(s), mood board, and installation proposal; 1 30 min follow up phone call; and one round of revisions.

A whole property design package is an offering to accommodate larger scale projects and includes an initial phone call to discuss scope and design goals, and a two-three hour onsite consultation to develop a property-wide design vision. The design budget range is based on property size, scope and complexity, and will be agreed upon on a case-by-case basis. This option is a great choice for a full property renovation project or new construction without any existing landscaping.

We draw from permaculture methods and ecological awareness to develop a site plan that meets clients' design goals, integrates their property into the larger landscape, and moves towards stability/lower inputs and reduced maintenance over time. Common elements of such projects include habitat integration/rewilding, food production, and on-site rainwater infiltration. We will create a design proposal that addresses clients' goals and unique site needs to support a whole-systems approach to managing their landscape.



After the onsite meeting with one of our designers, you will receive a written design concept, detailed planting plans, plant and materials lists, scope of work and installation estimate. This package also includes a follow up phone call to discuss the project and answer questions, one design revision, a second one hour onsite meeting for design walkthrough, and phased installation scheduling. Any subsequent design revisions or major changes to the scope will be billed at our design rate of \$125/hour.

Budgets for projects vary widely based on scale and complexity, but can be expected to be over \$10,000. We are happy to work with your budget and offer phased implementation and installation.
